



Competition Brief: Create a map of Barnsley borough showing some locations linked to the 'Hidden Artists of Barnsley'

Prize: The individual or team who produces the winning entry will receive a prize of **£50** and their entry will be displayed in the **Cooper Gallery** as part of **'The Hidden Art of Barnsley'** exhibition to be held at the gallery from **June-August 2014**. The judges may award other prizes at their discretion.

Entry Specification

- Entries must be approximately A1 size (approx. 84 x 59cm or 33 x 23.3 inches). They may be on paper, cardboard, canvas, fabric or other suitable material. BAYD will supply each entrant/team with a sheet of A1 paper upon request.
- A table of the 'hidden artists' and the Barnsley locations which featured in their lives is included in this pack. (Locations are highlighted in **blue**.) Entrants may choose whether to include some or all of these locations on their map. Entrants may include other Barnsley locations if they wish.
- Entrants may choose how to label and/or represent locations on their map. Entrants may use a key if they wish. If a key is used, it must be on the map itself rather than a separate sheet.
- The map should be an artistic work depicting Barnsley borough. It is not necessary for it to be to scale or for locations on it to be marked with a high level of accuracy.
- The reason each marked location is significant should be made clear on your map or on a key. However, it is not necessary to provide biographical information about the artists on your map or key. So, for example, if you decide to mark Woolley Pit on your map, you would need to put that Brain Fitzpatrick's father worked there (or include this on a key). You would not need to explain who Brian Fitzpatrick was or what he did. BAYD will ensure this information is available within the 'Hidden Art' exhibition.
- It is up to entrants to decide what medium/media to use to create their entry. However, entrants should bear in mind that entries must be suitable for display on a wall.
- All artwork on entries must be original artwork done by the entrant(s) named on the entry form submitted with that entry.
- Credit will be given for creativity, artistic skill and effective use of the information in this pack.

Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is open to everyone who lives, works, volunteers or learns within Barnsley Metropolitan Borough.

- 2. Entries can be produced by individuals or by teams of up to 6 people.
- 3. Everyone who has contributed directly to an entry must be listed as a team member on the entry form submitted with that entry.
- 4. The competition is open to people of all ages, but the age group of each entrant/team member must be indicated on their/their team's entry form.
- 5. An entry form must be filled in for each entry and submitted to BAYD with the entry it concerns.
- 6. Entry forms can be filled in by entrants, by their parents/guardians/carers, or by any adult who knows an entrant/all the members of a team and is happy to be contacted about that individual/team's entry. BAYD will address any communication regarding an entry to the person whose contact details are on the form for that entry.
- 7. Entries must fulfil the entry specification given above.
- 8. All entries must be delivered to:

BAYD will collect entries from within Barnsley Metropolitan Borough upon request.

- 9. The closing date for entries is 17/04/2014.
- 10. The competition will be judged by a panel of judges. The decision of the judging panel is final. BAYD will contact the person whose contact details are on the winning entry's entry form after 17/04/2014. The prize of £50 will be presented or sent to this person. We regret that we will not be able to contact all entrants. However, we will be happy to respond to enquiries.
- 11. Once entries are submitted to BAYD, they will become the property of BAYD until 30/08/2014. BAYD will have the right to display and photograph entries whilst they are in its possession. This includes displaying photographs of entries on its website and facebook page. BAYD will be happy to return entries to entrants after 30/08/2014. However, it will be the responsibility of an entrant/team's contact person to arrange for that entrant/team's entry to be collected from BAYD. If an entrant/team wishes their entry to be returned to them, BAYD must be informed of this before 30/08/2014.
- 12. BAYD will do its utmost to ensure that no entries are lost, damaged or destroyed. However, it cannot guarantee this and will not accept any responsibility for entries being lost, damaged or destroyed.

Data Protection

- BAYD will treat all information provided on entry forms in the strictest of confidence and will not display these forms.
- BAYD requires the full name of one contact person for each entry. Otherwise, entrants may be listed by their first name only.
- When displaying entries, BAYD will display the names of the entrant(s) listed on each entry
 form in the form they are given there, unless otherwise instructed by the entrant/team's
 contact person. Entrants/Teams who do not wish their names to be displayed should write
 this on the back of their entrance form or ask their contact person to do so.

Entrants/Teams may use the back of their entrance form to provide BAYD with a pseudonym or team name (e.g. 'Kings Road School, Group 2') to use when displaying their entry. Entrants/Teams who wish their entry to be completely anonymous, should write this on the back of their form. In such cases, BAYD will display entries with an entry number and an indication of the age(s) of the entrant/team members.

- BAYD will only use contact details provided on entry forms for communication about the competition entered, unless permission to do otherwise is expressly given.
- BAYD will destroy all competition entry forms within 2 years of 30/08/2014.
- BAYD may show entry forms to the 'Heritage Lottery Fund' to provide evidence of participation in this competition.
